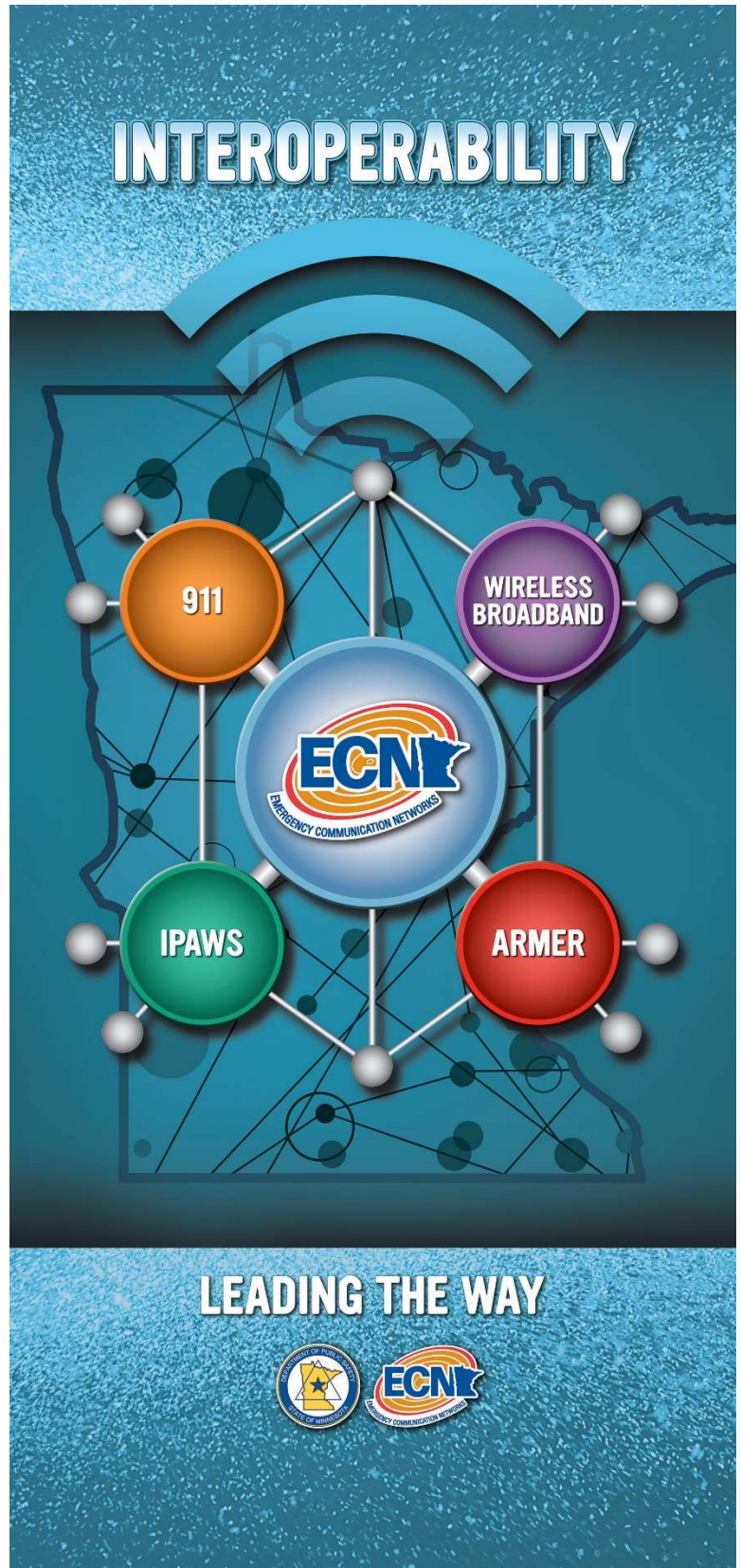


The Division of Emergency Communication Networks encompasses five programs and manages two critical public safety communication networks.

The Statewide 911 Program manages the 911 network, the Allied Radio Matrix for Emergency Response (ARMER) statewide shared radio communications network is managed under the ARMER Program, the Statewide Interoperability Program aims to improve the communications of Minnesota's first responders regardless of the radio systems they have in place, IPAWS is used by state, tribal, and local authorities to send emergency warnings within their jurisdictions, and Wireless Broadband deals with the national FirstNet program that is innovating a network designed for and by Public Safety.
